(This evidence shall be submitted to the school no later than January 1 of the first year that a three (3) or four (4) year old is enrolled)

- _____ Kentucky Immunization Certificate
- _____ Kentucky Physical/Preventative Health Exam on KY Student Physical Exam Form
(This physical may be completed up to one (1) year prior to entry at SJS)
- _____ Kentucky Eye Exam (Kindergarten)
(This evidence shall be submitted to the school no later than January 1 of the first year that a five (5) or six (6) year old is enrolled at SJS)
- _____ Kentucky Dental Exam/Screening
(This must be completed by a dentist, dental hygienist, physician, registered nurse, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant and submitted to the school no later than January 1 or the first year that a five (5) or six (6) year old is enrolled at SJS.)

INCOMING 6TH GRADE STUDENTS (Current 5th Grade Students)

- _____ Kentucky Physical/Preventative Health Care Exam dated Feb. 1, 2017 or later.
- _____ Kentucky Immunization Certificate (Updated)
- _____ Hepatitis B (required for all children born on or after October 1, 1992)
- _____ T-Dap Vaccine regardless of first dose of this immunization
- _____ Meningococcal Vaccine
- _____ Varicella Vaccine (Chicken Pox) – second dose OR Physician documentation that the child has had this disease.
